- 1. Summer Camp The client attended the Lake Land FASD camp in Cold Lake during the summer of 2024. He has never been away from his parents at all. He was a little apprehensive about going. He enjoyed the camp so much when he came home. He said to his Mom I am getting older and can only go to camp a couple more times before I cannot go again. This is truly a success story. The funder Angela was told about this story and found a camp for young adults to attend for FASD and the client is very happy about this. "
- 2. In Reach I have a client who is doing really well, he has come out of treatment and has been doing exceptionally well in the community. He is going to school to upgrade for the job he would like. He spoke with his probation officer and is doing so well they approved him to go to B.C. with his son and his Girlfriend. He has been sober for six months, and has been working really hard to better his life.
- 3. FASD Mentorship Client has been Taekwondo for 13 years, has been taking classes since he was 7 years old. This year he is proud to be apart of the TEAM CANADA TAEKWONDO club. and went to Puebla, Mexico to compete internationally and won 2 GOLD metals, One for Poomsae, and one for Sparring. - 4. PCAP Participant has been living with a roommate, and renting a spare room, mentor supported client in getting Aish application finished. Client was able to get Aish and all tax papers up to date (utilizing community programs such as FCSS tax support) Client then found a place to rent as mentor had been supporting her looking for an apartment. 


